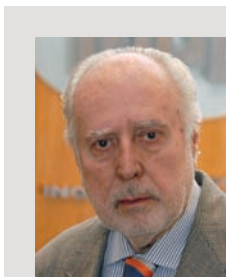

He earned a PhD degree in chemical sciences from the University of La Plata.
